The school includes:

- introduction to the science behind the system
- overviews on instruments/data/models of interest

- data model and ontology
- practical “hands-on” sessions on the usage of the system

The programme includes a total of 20 hours of lectures and practical sessions to be delivered by expert scientists in the field.

A certificate of attendance for 1 ECTS (European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System) will be issued to the students attending the Training School.
